

## OHTA Sue Davies Prize – List of Priority Countries

### Criteria

- (1) Those applicants permanently resident in a country considered a developing economy (with less than 25% US GDP per capita, and without an industrial hygiene association that is a member of IOHA) will normally be given priority by the judging panel
- (2) Population is >1 million (Note: it is considered that below this population size there would not be sufficient infrastructure, together with their GDP, to support an industrial hygiene program).
